FM system requests for students with APD, ADHD etc. - how C.A.S.E. can help

Equipment

- Borrowing/loaning equipment If there is appropriate equipment instock, it will be available to borrow. Requests will be made through the Itinerant Administrator.
- C.A.S.E. will provide you with the information about the current F.M. systems that are in the building so that compatibility/frequency issues can be discussed when ordering
- C.A.S.E. audiologist available for recommendations about what equipment to purchase
- C.A.S.E. itinerants will check malfunctioning equipment upon request. They can attempt to determine whether or not a piece of equipment will need to be shipped back to the company for repair or replacement.

Training

• Requests for training can be made through the C.A.S.E. Itinerant Administrator. An itinerant will train the student's case manager on FM use, equipment and maintenance. The case manager will then be responsible for training the rest of the building staff.
