Thank you for your interest in our software.

Mind Express doesn't collect any user data. All Mind Express files and settings are stored locally and Jabbla doesn't have access to these files.

There is a feature in Mind Express to store a backup in the cloud, but in this case the backup is store on a personal Google Drive. Jabbla doesn't have access to this drive nor to the login information for the drive.

To launch Mind Express you need a username and password. The admin of the license can choose any nickname as username. The password is encrypted and Jabbla cannot retrieve this password.
