

Agreement Regarding Student Use of Assistive Technology Device at Home or in Other Settings

It has been determined by your child's IEP Team that an Assistive Technology Device _____ is necessary for him/her to receive a free appropriate public education. The IEP Team has also determined that your child needs access to this Assistive Technology Device at home or in other settings.

The Assistive Technology Device is the property of the School District or Special Education Cooperative (CASE). If the device is lost, stolen or damaged, it is your responsibility to notify the school immediately. If it is determined by school officials that the Assistive Technology Device or any component thereof has been damaged through normal everyday use, wear and tear, the School District will repair or replace the device at no cost to you. However, if the School District determines that the Assistive Technology Device has been lost, stolen or has become damaged through negligence or misuse, it will be your responsibility to replace and/or repair the device.
